

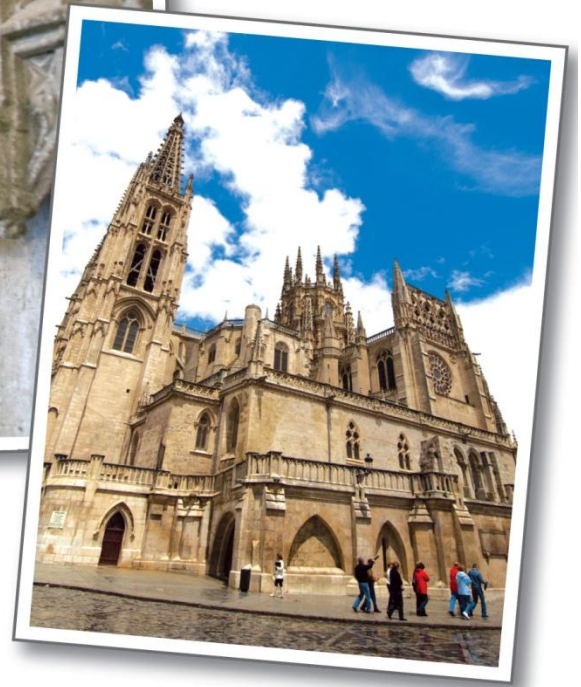

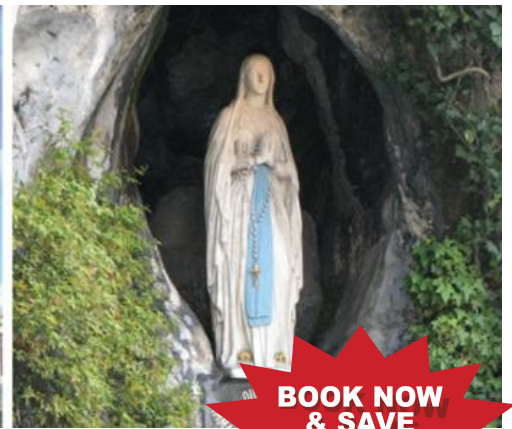

**Day 1: Sunday, October 7, 2012
Overnight Flight**

Travel overnight to Portugal, one of Europe's most hospitable countries. Here you can enjoy a superb climate, historic sites, and beautiful scenery.

**Day 2: Monday, October 8, 2012
Fatima, Portugal - Tour Begins**

Your tour begins in Fatima, Portugal's world-famous religious center. *Today dinner will be included.*

**Day 3: Tuesday, October 9, 2012
Fatima**

Join the local parishioners in celebrating Mass before exploring the Basilica to see the Tombs of Francisco and Jacinta and its grounds. **Travel to Aljustrel, where the children lived, and the Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared after the children's return from prison.** This afternoon view the Batalha Monastery, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and an example of Manueline architecture. This evening, enjoy time for

devotion and worship. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

**Day 4: Wednesday, October 10, 2012
Fatima - Burgos, Spain**

Discover the origin and history of the Spanish language with a brief lesson of key words and phrases provided by your Tour Manager. Attend a morning Mass before travelling east to Burgos, known as the cradle of the Castile region. Situated on the Pilgrim's Road, Burgos stands on the banks of the Rio Arlazon with the slender, elegant spires of its famous cathedral rising into the sky. Mass is available this evening. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

**Day 5: Thursday, October 11, 2012
Burgos**

Join a local expert on a leisurely-paced walking tour of Burgos' beautiful medieval town center. Visit the Cathedral of Burgos, a masterpiece of Spanish gothic architecture, and a UNESCO World Heritage site. The cathedral, the third largest church in

Spain, offers such masterpieces as the filigree work in the spires of the towers, the starry dome, the choir, the sarcophagi and the golden staircase. Next, on the outskirts of the city, visit the medieval Carthusian Santa Maria de Miraflores Monastery with its intricately carved and gilded wood altar and alabaster sepulchers, considered to be amongst the most important late Gothic works in Spain. Mass is available this evening. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

**Day 6: Friday, October 12, 2012
Burgos - Lourdes, France**

Mass is available before you travel northeast through the Pyrenees to Lourdes. This is where the Virgin Mary appeared in the Grotto of Massabielle to the poor shepherd girl, Bernadette, a total of 18 times between February 11 - July 16, 1858. This little market town has been a world-renowned pilgrimage site ever since. Tonight you may wish to partake in a candlelight procession*.



Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

**Day 7: Saturday, October 13, 2012
Lourdes**

After morning Mass enjoy a walking tour of Lourdes, visiting the places associated with the life of St. Bernadette: the "Boly Mill" (site of the birthplace of St. Bernadette), the "Cachot," and the parish church, housing the baptismal font of St. Bernadette. Later, at leisure, explore the town's rich historical and natural heritage and be submerged in the atmosphere that reigned during the apparitions and the spirit of brotherhood that is still present today. *Today breakfast, lunch and dinner will be included.*

**Day 8: Sunday, October 14, 2012
Lourdes - Carcassone - Barcelona, Spain**

Celebrate Mass before travelling through southern France's Pyrenees Mountains to Carcassone. Enjoy some leisure time to explore this beautiful, historic town and its medieval atmosphere. Later, cross back into Spain and travel to fascinating Barcelona, one of Europe's most popular cities. *Today breakfast will be included.*

**Day 9: Monday, October 15, 2012
Barcelona**

Get an in-depth look at Barcelona with a tour that showcases Las Ramblas Boulevard, Columbus

Monument and Parc Montjuic. You will also view Antonio Gaudi's masterpieces: Mila House, Parc Guell and "La Sagrada Familia," all UNESCO World Heritage sites. The afternoon is at leisure for independent exploration or you may join an optional excursion to the quaint mountain village of Montserrat. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a dinner celebrating the end of a memorable tour. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

**Day 10: Tuesday, October 16, 2012
Barcelona - Tour Ends**

You return home eager to share vivid memories of a spectacularly beautiful land with an old, rich and diverse cultural heritage. *Today breakfast will be included.*

*In Fatima & Lourdes, available from Easter through the end of October, is the candlelight procession (every night at 9 P.M.) and the procession for the sick (every day at 3 P.M.).

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

In Lourdes, due to seasonality, one of the three sister hotels listed will be used for your accommodations; specific hotel confirmation is subject to change.

To complete your vacation, we include roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing Collette airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Collette air passengers will arrive into the Lisbon, Portugal airport. All Collette transfers will depart from the Lisbon airport for Estoril.

This tour requires average physical activity. You should be in good health, able to climb stairs and walk reasonable distances, possibly over uneven grounds and cobblestone streets.

Experience It!

Burgos...Land of Cathedrals

Burgos was founded in 884 and its historical heritage is immediately evident. Admittedly, its main sights are ecclesiastical, most notably the cathedral itself, but it is an atmospheric place and has a rare grandeur and medieval northern Castilian ambience.

The Cathedral of Burgos, completed in 1222, is among the most admired of its kind worldwide. Especially remarkable are its portal, the "Puerta del Sarmental," considered the best example of Gothic sculpture of its century. The Cathedral of Burgos is modeled after the French cathedral of Bourges and reflects the Gothic style made popular in Spain by the Cistercian Order.
